

Pastor's Corner





Dear People of God,

Thank you to those of you who participated in yesterday's Town Hall. This was in preparation for the requested compilation of our parish's response to the larger Future of Our Parishes North City Deanery Task Force. We will be notified of the larger body's recommendations as they happen.

The Archdiocesan Office of Worship has suggested some ways to reduce the risk of the spread of organisms in light of the recent happenings around the coronavirus. Among them is to suspend the administration of the use of the chalices to the assembly for our Masses and to distribute the Sacrament singly from our patens and ciborium from the tabernacle. We are still receiving the full sacramental Body and Blood of Christ, gratefully to the Spirit of the Lord invocated into the both visible elements of what we refer to beforehand as bread and wine. Let me know your thoughts. If we move on this, perhaps it would be as early as next Sunday, March 15. Please note that some parishes have already regularly suspended or do not administer with the chalices as precautions during regular flu season and other times. It could also affect the number of Eucharistic ministers who are needed to serve.


WELCOME TO OUR VISITORS!


