SPIRITUAL COMMUNION

Receiving the Blessed Sacrament in the Eucharist is the source and summit of our Catholic faith, but during these unprecedented times and to ensure the health and safety of all people, it is not possible to receive the Sacrament publicly during this time. However, there are still opportunities to draw close to Christ and unite with the Church during these difficult times.

While we are unable to receive the Blessed Sacrament during the next several weeks, we encourage all parishioners to take the opportunity to receive the blessings bestowed upon us through a Spiritual Communion. Spiritual Communion is an opportunity to still be able to unite ourselves to the Sacrament. The basic elements of an Act of Spiritual Communion are an Act of Faith; an Act of Love; a desire to receive Christ; and an invitation to Him to come into your heart. Families or individuals can be encouraged to receive Spiritual Communion in the following manner.

STEPS FOR A SPIRITUAL COMMUNION

- Find a quiet space
- Begin with the Sign of the Cross

Blessed Continual Easter/Resurrection Season to you!

As stated last week, Archbishop Carlson announced permission for public Masses to resume on Monday, May 18. We have received the guidelines but also noting that not all parishes will be resuming at the same time and that the decisions are subject to change based on any new data provided by health officials. We will resume at St. Nicholas after having been oriented with and demonstrating readiness to put into place the information about sanitation, hygiene, personal protective equipment and liturgical procedures. Until then, please check your listings for Masses on the EWTN network on television and http://www.archstl.org/ coronavirus for locally streamed sources.

Unless otherwise advised, St. Nicholas Church will be open today, May 17 and May 24 at 10:30 a.m. for Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament, individual praver, devotions and the Sacrament of Reconciliation upon request. Palms that we have are still available for you. Be mindful that the general dispensation from the Sunday Mass obligation will continue for all Catholics of the archdiocese until further notice as many people are still concerned about their health and safety and of those around them even as we practice the restrictions during public Mass. The directives and their highlights are quite involved and are being offered widely through communication with me. I will be asking a group of representatives from our ministries to help us coordinate the forward movement. We want to think through our particular circumstances and not move too hastily but appropriately.

Thank you to those of you who have continued to make financial contributions. We continue to thank God for you too!

Call the office as needed. I will respond as I can and attempt to keep us informed. Keep being cautious in your daily life as you stay "prayed-up". Our Lady, Health of the Sick, pray for us.

Mass Intentions


